#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE ROTARY CLUBS TORINO CAVOUR E SUD EST AND KÖLN-KASTELL.

- The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to describe the main contact arrangements between the Twin Clubs Rotary Clubs of Torino Cavour e Sud Est and Rotary Club Köln-Kastell aimed at fostering the relationship amongst the members and the cooperation amongst the clubs.
- Each Twin Club is determined to establish a long-term relationship aimed at promoting international understanding and goodwill and carry out service projects in their respective communities via a friendship exchange, as a way to make new friends and establish international service partnerships.
- Each club will regularly inform the contact club of their main programs and of the
  projects of possible common interest, which is undertaking or plans to undertake,
  in order to implement joint projects, whenever possible.
- 4. One official visit shall be planned every year on a rotation basis. The month and date of the visit will be jointly determined by the two presidents at the beginning of each Rotarian year (i.e. preferably before the end of August of each year).
- The official visit will take place in the city of the host club unless a different location will be proposed by the host club and approved by the visiting club.
- The host club will send, at least three months in advance, a tentative program with
  the possible accommodations. The visiting club shall indicate the tentative number
  of participants as soon as possible in order to allow the host club to confirm the
  reservations two months in advance.
- 7. The visiting club should be represented ideally by at least 5 members, not including spouses or children. Unless otherwise agreed, each official visit will preferably last a minimum of three days (for instance, from Friday to Sunday) and will include an official dinner.
- The participants of each club will bear its own costs and it is agreed not to exchange gifts.
- 9. Each club will designate at least one of the members to oversee the relations within the clubs, who will regularly maintain the contacts and coordinate the exchange information on the projects, in cooperation with the member of each Club in charge of the International Relationships and together with the acting Secretary and President of the Clubs for each Rotarian year.
- Each member is warmly encouraged to visit the contact club on any possible additional occasion, besides the official yearly meetings.
- 11. This memorandum of understanding will be valid for an initial period of two years and shall be considered automatically renewed for additional two years periods, unless a notice in writing will be sent to the President of the other club six months before the next renewal period.
