

THE INTER COUNTRY COMMITTEE (ICC) GOES TO DISCOVER ROTARY PROJECTS IN MOZAMBIQUE

On 23 June 23 2024, we left Cagliari for a long journey to discover Rotary projects that can help the needs of a beautiful and resourceful country like Mozambique.

We found an incredibly welcoming country, where human values and civic respect make you feel part of a large community, without cultural differences.



In the district of Matola (Maputo) we visited the Muchisso school where in one day from 06:00 to 17:30, 47 teachers look after two thousand children.

Poverty is considerable, but the desire to learn is great. There are children, even very young ones, who walk 10 km a day to have the privilege (because that is how they see it) of going to school.

Unfortunately, there are not enough classrooms, and lessons are also held sitting in the shade of large trees. All with great harmony and respect for the institutions.

We then visited the Casa Madre Maria Clara Orphanage located in the Mission of S. José de Lhanguene in Maputo and managed by Sister Elisa.

The compound hosts a community of about 100 orphans who study and manage the entire orphanage. A local charity organization teaches the girls the techniques of growing vegetables or fruit trees of all kinds. This fantastic community needs to renovate a small room to create a space for computers and IT education.

At the age of 18/20, the girls lose their right to live inside the Casa Madre Maria Clara. Learning to use a computer could help them find a future job in different sectors.

Finally, we were invited to participate in the Presidential Handover of the Rotary Club Maputo (D-9400), where Richard Knowlton - President of the Italy, Malta, San Marino Section of the Inter-Country Committee with Mozambique - explained to a particularly attentive audience, the importance of Rotary's Inter-Country Committees and the need to create cultivate understanding and collaboration that fosters peace between countries in the world.
